The project “CICLO - Boosting the Circular Economy skills of the EU services Labor force” that aims to upgrade and multiply the opportunities for **up-skilling and re-skilling of long-term unemployed and low-skilled workers, in the field of the evolving circular economy market**, is very happy to announce the launch of its [platform in 6 national languages](#). The 8 modules of CICLO found on the platform are:

6. Soft Skills for the Circular Economy II

Upon completion of the course, CICLO offers the possibility to the users to get their certification according to the European Qualifications Framework (EQF).

CICLO could be included in educational and other services offered by Vocational Education and Training (VET) providers, Training Centres in general, Higher Education Institutions, and Open Schools, as well as for stakeholders in EU labour force, NGOs, SMEs, and Public Services as it can enhance the skills of the long-term unemployed and low-skilled workers and maximize their access to the labour market. For this purpose, CICLO is preparing an **adaptation and policy package (e-book) with specific guidelines for stakeholders** on how to integrate the CICLO training package into their normal training activities, how to utilise it as a VET component and how the modules and trainees can be accredited based on ECVET.
